



## H-PETTE<sup>®</sup> with Blade Instructions For Use

1. Place H-Pette's cannula in the center of the stopper of the collection tube. Gently press until the cannula completely penetrates the septum. The tube is now ready for use. Caution: cannula is sharp; care should be taken in handling.



2. Invert tube at an angle with paddle side up as shown. Gently press the round edge of the H-Pette to the glass slide to transfer sample to the slide.



 Grasping the circular disk as shown, rotate tube to turn paddle side down. Use H-Pette's plastic blade just as you would a glass slide. A 15-25° angle of incidence gives optimum results. H-Pette can be removed with the H-Pette Remover tool according to the instructions provided, or disposed with the collection tube.
